KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

A/Prof Paul Anantharajah Tambyah

Paul Anantharajah Tambyah is currently Associate Professor, Dept of Medicine, National University of Singapore, Assistant Dean, Faculty of Medicine, National University of Singapore, Consultant Infectious Disease Physician, National University Hospital, Singapore and Visiting Consultant, Alexandra Hospital, Singapore.

He is on the editorial board of the 'Singapore Medical Journal' and is an ad hoc manuscript reviewer for various journals including 'Asia Pacific Journal of Public Health', 'Eur J Clin Micro & ID' and 'BMJ'. Professor Tambyah has won several awards the most recent of which were the National University of Singapore Special University Award for being part of SARS online module team (2004).

Dr Stephan Harbarth

Stephan Harbarth is currently senior research associate, hospital epidemiologist and attending physician at the University Hospital, Geneva, Switzerland. He has made outstanding contributions in the field of infectious disease epidemiology, focusing on prevention and control of nosocomial infections and antimicrobial resistance in hospitals. In addition he pioneered studies on the cultural and regulatory factors that influence antimicrobial use in different countries.

His studies on the impact and control of nosocomial MRSA transmission have increased understanding of the epidemiology of MRSA and improved the ability to combat this microorganism. His research on the adverse effects of prolonged antibiotic prophylaxis after surgery and on the ecologic bias associated with group-level data analyses of antibiotic-use-versus-resistance relationships have been important contributions to the field of antibiotic resistance also impacted on policy making.
